select a palette of colors that blend well from one room to another, says Leona Piro of Act Two Home Staging in Mendon. The arrangement of colors is what creates flow and harmony in a home. For example, browns, café latte, and shades of gold create a nice flow. With an open floor plan, you might choose gold for the kitchen, a deeper shade of gold for the adjoining family room, brown for the dining room and café latte for the home office. By planning ahead, each room becomes a piece of a whole and well-decorated home, Piro says.

To further unify the rooms of a home, be consistent with window trim and door colors, Piro suggests.

Similar flooring in open rooms also creates flow and harmony. When using similar wall colors from room to room, you can still give rooms a distinctive character by featuring different accent colors. Add area rugs to give a room its own personality. □
